

## PROMPT SHEET FOR COMPETITIONS AND PROMOTIONS

### ZM TERMS AND CONDITIONS – DOUBLE DATE

ZM is giving listeners the chance to win \$100,000 with the promotion “Double Date”.

#### Promotional Period

The Promotional Period is from 8am 23 April 2018 to 9am 1 June 2018, unless the Promoter discontinues the Promotion prior to 1 June 2018.

To enter the competition participants must:

1. Be over the age of 18;
2. Be able to provide a valid driver's license or passport as confirmation of birth, and any associated documentation requested by the Promoter in claiming a Prize under this promotion)

The following people shall be INELIGIBLE to participate: Current or former employees, family members, agents, successors, or assignees of the Sponsor or any promotional agency involved with this promotion.

#### Entry Mechanics

To be announced as an Announced Winner:

1. During the Promotion Period the ZM announcers will announce at 8am every week day during the promotional period (excluding public holidays) a Promotion Opportunity by asking for people to phone into ZM if they are born in a certain month.
2. Two callers will be randomly selected to continue with the promotion opportunity on air.
3. Prior to being broadcast on air, the selected callers will be required to provide their full name to the Promoter. This call will be recorded by NZME. Radio Limited. The full name of callers will not be broadcast on air, but is required for identity verification purposes.
4. On air, the announcer will ask the first caller what month they were born.
5. They will then ask the second caller what month they were born.
6. Provided all other conditions are met, if the month matches the callers will be eligible for a prize of \$100 each (each an Announced Winner). This is Prize Level C.
7. The announcer will then ask the first caller what day they were born (0-31).
8. They will then ask the second caller what day of the month (0-31) they were born.
9. Provided all the Conditions are met, if the day and month match the callers will be eligible for a prize of \$1000 each (each an Announced Winner). This is Prize Level B.
10. The announcer will ask the callers what year they were born in.
11. Provided all Conditions are met, if the day, month and year match (being a Winning Contestant Combo), the Announced Winners will be eligible for a prize of \$100,000 each (each an Announced Winner). This is Prize Level A.

## Prize Details

The Prize consists of:

- Prize Level C: \$100 each (\$200 total) for those who get through on-air by phoning 0800 DIAL ZM and they were each born in the specified month;
- Prize Level B: \$1,000 each (\$2,000 total) if the day and month of participant birthdays match up for the two callers on the line;
- Prize Level A: \$100,000 each (\$200,000 total) if the day, month and year matches of the two callers on the phone line.

Entrants may only win a prize once.

To claim the Prize, the Prize Winners must provide the Promoter with all information requested including, but not limited to, government acceptable identification, details of a nominated bank account for receiving the Prize. If this information is not provided promptly (within 48 hours of being requested to send identification to the designated ZM contact) the Prize Winner will forfeit the prize.

Additionally, ZM may ask you to partake in measures which will assist us and our partners to conduct a relevant investigation, including, but not limited to, you participating in a polygraph (lie detection) test as a condition for payment of the prize. The costs of such a test will not be payable by the winner(s). Participants grant the Promoter permission to use their name, photograph, voice and film recordings in which they appear, in connection with the Promotion and for future promotion and marketing purposes and waive any claims to royalty, right or remuneration for such use. This includes the right to use on the Promoter's websites, Facebook pages, on air and other publications of the Promoter.
